*Team fees are cost recovery, which is based on number of students involved, number of games and tournaments and distance expected to travel. Team supervisors are to submit a proposal with all fees outlined prior to the season. Any amount of \$10 or more per player remaining at the end of the season will result in a refund to the player in the form of a cheque.

**Field trips are based on cost recovery.

Students with unpaid school fees will not be permitted to participate in extracurricular events, such as school teams, clubs and field trips. Parents must either pay the fees in their entirety at the beginning of the school year, or contact the school administration to set up a payment schedule in order for their child to participate in extracurricular events. Fee waivers must be discussed with the principal.

Students must have current permission forms and all curricular/extracurricular fees paid in full prior to participation in order to be eligible to participate in curricular/extracurricular events. Please contact the school administration to set up a payment schedule for extracurricular fees if this is required.

Please be advised that all fees contain a 1.5% district processing fee for online cash payments relating to the processing of credit card charges. It should be noted that the DO Processing fee is only a partial cost recovery, and will not cover all of the online costs (which will be paid for by Division Office).

Distance Learning/Online Fees

When students enroll in courses via Distance Learning/Online, there are additional fees that may apply to enrolling in outside courses. Refundable deposits, textbook fees and material costs, in many cases, must be covered by students. The below information identifies information for various scenarios, and the costs associated with those course selections.

Scenario 1: Student elect to take courses that BHS does not offer, or there are course conflicts beyond the student's control.

- Students will pay a reimbursable deposit fee that is reimbursable after the student completes and passes the course. There is a significant amount of work required of school staff when students enroll in distance/online courses. This reimbursable deposit will defray costs incurred by the school should the student not successfully complete the course.
- Should charges for materials be applied by the distance learning/online school, students will be required to pay these charges. When courses are taken in the online environment, there are no additional module/assignment fees. In 'print-version' courses, module and assignment packages are required by students and are consumable documents. Distance Learning will charge for these materials. These charges are not part of the refundable deposit fee and are required to be paid directly by the student.
- Students may utilize a BHS textbook free of charge, if BHS has the textbook available. Otherwise, the student must utilize a Distance Learning/Online textbook and pay any applicable Distance Learning/Online textbook fees.

Scenario 2: BHS offers the requested online/distance course within the school's timetable, there are no course conflicts, and the student elects to enroll in the Distance Learning/Online course.

Effective September 2017

- Students must contact, enroll, manage, and maintain contact with the distance learning/online school managing the course; BHS will not provide support to students for this process or during the course.
- All associated fees will be dealt with directly between the student and the distance learning/online school. BHS will not be involved in this process.

Effective September 2018

- Students will pay a tuition fee that is non-refundable.
- Students will pay full costs of materials provided by Distance Learning/Online, should charges apply.
- Students utilize an Distance Learning/Online textbook and applicable Distance Learning/Online fees will be charged to the student.

Transportation (White Buses) Fee Schedule

WHEREAS there has been increasing expenses towards the maintenance of the white buses utilized for extra-curricular activities and field trips, upwards of \$10000 in maintenance per year;
 WHEREAS extracurricular and field trip fees have been kept as low as possible for as long as possible;
 WHEREAS there is no longer any money in the school's budget to cover the maintenance expenses for the buses to meet registration and inspection requirements;
 WHEREAS the Breton High School School Council supports the recommendation to implement transportation fees to users of the white buses;
 BHS is required to institute transportation fees to all user groups utilizing the BHS white buses.
 The following fee schedule will be utilized to determine fees required by various user groups:

High Volume Usage Extra-curricular Activities (including but not limited to Volleyball, Basketball, Football)	\$ 50.00 per student
Low Volume Usage Extra-curricular Activities (including but not limited to Track and Field, Badminton, Golf, Cross-Country)	\$15.00 per student
One-Time Usage Extra-curricular/Field Trip Activities (Skiing, Field Trips)	\$5.00 per student
Internal User Group Mileage Rate (all BHS groups to be charged mileage)	\$0.75 per kilometre
External User Group Mileage Rate	\$1.00 per kilometre

These fees will be included within the student fee to participate in the activity/field trip. They will not be stand alone fees.
