Remembrance Day Assembly



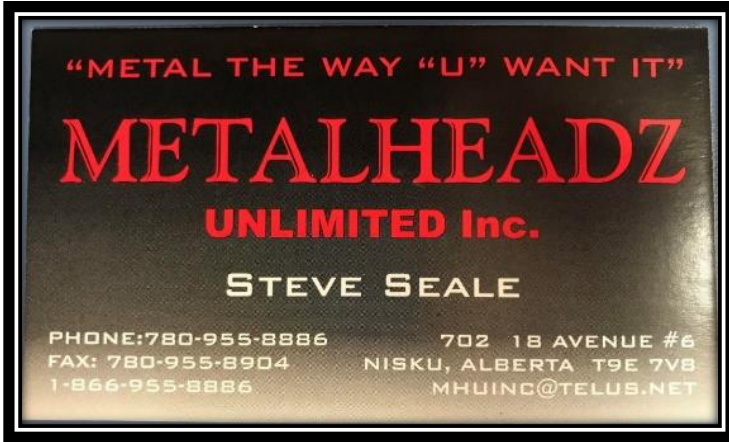
You are welcome to join Breton High School as we acknowledge Remembrance Day with a special assembly on Friday, November 8th at approximately 10:45am in the gym.
