

#### From the office:

Need help getting on PowerSchool? Please call our office for assistance

Student Demographics forms will be emailed to parents/guardians at the beginning of September and they need to be completed online as soon as possible.

While we are located in Warburg School, our entry doors are located at the parking lot. Please use these doors so we don't disrupt Warburg School. If you need to enter the school, you will need to buzz in to gain entry. If students are late for class, either before school or after lunch, they will need to buzz in and sign in at the office.

If students need to leave early, parents must call or come into the school to sign them out. Students must also sign out at the office.

Students are permitted to use the office before or after school, during lunch or at break times. During the remainder of the day, the office may be utilized to sign in or sign out or during an emergency or if they are sent by a teacher.

Chromebooks are used throughout our division, this year we will have chromebooks available to students to sign out providing a completed Chromebook Contract has been given to the Learning Commons Facilitator. Chromebook Contract is attached if you require one.

Chromebook deposits from last year have been issued. If you paid online, it will be refunded online. If you paid by cash or cheque, a cheque or EFT will be issued to the address we have on file.

Cell phones must be left in the locker or at home. They are not to be used during the day other than before or after school or at lunch. Parents will need to contact the office to either talk to your child or to leave a message. If students are on their phone, it will be taken to the office and the student can collect it after 3:05pm. For repeat offenders, parents will need to come in to pickup their student's phone. Students can use the phone in the office in an emergency or during the lunch break.


